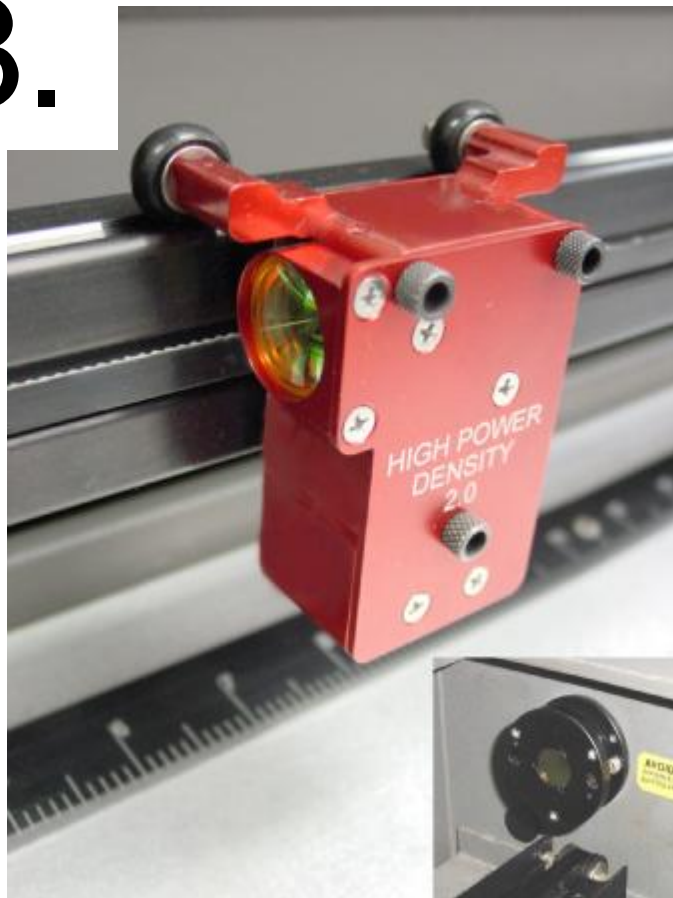
Take photo, scan or import into a photo editing software and remove background and or crop to desired look.

2.



Increase contrast and brightness till image appears to be washed out as shown.

Using the HPDFO lens run at high power and low speed

-Example
M-360 50 Watt, Run at 100%Power, 45% Speed, 1000 PPI and at DEN 5 halftone mode

Do not Use Image Enhancement

Finished result produces a very sharp, high contrast photo in wood.

Cherry and alder wood are recommended for best results
