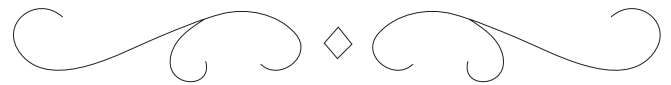


Many of the ornamentals we use come from the engraving environment. Here is an example of an ornament that was originally save in the HPGL (PLT) format and imported into CorelDRAW.

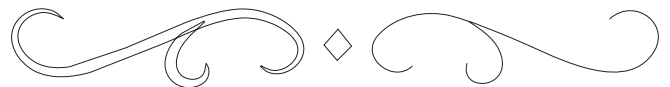
After we select the object with the Pick Tool, we can look at the Status Bar and see that the ornament is a curve.



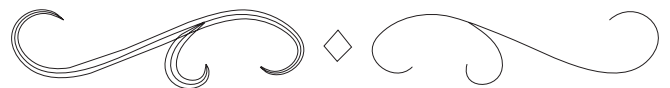
Our first step is to break the curve apart, and change the line width to Hairline.



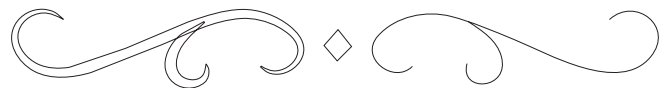
Next, select the Artistic Media Tool. Make sure the Preset Icon is selected, the Artistic Media Tool Width is .05, and the Preset Stroke List is like the one selected below:



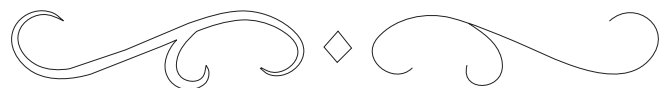
In the Arrange Menu, select Break Artistic Media Group Apart to convert to a curve.



Delete the inner line that was created with the Artistic Media Tool



Weld the two pieces together.



Duplicate and mirror the left half to complete the ornament. You can also fill it to make it stand out.
