• Raised Braille is read internationally by the Blind. This font meets all access codes required for the hand-capped for public buildings.

• What distinguishes the numbers 1-0 from letters a-j is that the numbers have the number sign # preceding them. The numbers for this font have been created in the following manner: For a single numeral, such as the number 2, simply type the number 2 on your keyboard. However, for numbers of two digits or more, type the number sign # and then the corresponding letter. So for the number 426, type #dbf. This would also apply for phone numbers: for 402-488-0981 type #djb-dhh-jlha  
To switch to words after typing a number or series of numbers, precede the first letter with the letter sign, which is on your keyboard as &. For capital letters, either type the letter, such as B, or the capital sign, which is on your keyboard as ^, then the lower case letter b. The end result is the same. When typing a word in all caps, precede the first letter with the
